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## About the project

The project aims to educate adult educators to approach and respond to the needs of adult learners, through different teaching methods and strategies, in order to support and provide them with a wider opportunity for learning, education, employment, and social interaction. Thus, educators will be prepared to work with the target group in regular classes together with other adult learners. In this way, inclusion will be achieved, and the classroom will be a space for socialization and interaction between a diverse group of adults.

## OUR EXPECTED RESULTS

### TRAINING PROGRAMME

In-Service Training Programme for Adult Educators comprising lessons for face-to-face learning and e-learning. Training will improve educators' knowledge and skills to successfully work with adult learners with learning and behavioural difficulties or disabilities.

### TOOLKIT FOR EDUCATORS

Toolkit: a set of tasks and an e-Diary for adult educators after the completion of the training programme. This will help them self-reflect on their skills and knowledge, the difficulties they encounter, and ways of improving their work with adults with disabilities.

### E-LEARNING PLATFORM

Online Platform for e-learning containing 50 hours of online training programme. The purpose of the platform is for adult educators to increase their self-directed learning skills, share their experiences, and doubts with other educators and their mentors, and reflect on competences they seek to develop during and after the training.

### TARGET GROUP

Adults with learning and behavioural difficulties and disabilities between 25 and 65 years;

Educators working in adult education organizations (formal/ nonformal)
